

SUPERINTENDENT'S ROLE IN NEGOTIATIONS

The superintendent is entitled to be present at all negotiation meetings of the employee units and the negotiation committee.

Out of his/her knowledge of the school system and practice elsewhere, the superintendent is expected to provide information and counsel to the negotiation committee; in matters of bargaining, he/she shall work in the best interests of the school system as a whole.

The superintendent is to advise the School Board in accordance with his/her best professional judgment.
