

EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

The evaluation of the instructional program shall be a major responsibility of the Superintendent and his/her staff with annual reports being presented to the Board to enable judgments to be made on the success of the program. No instructional program should be considered as the final answer, and all school programs shall be under continuous study by the staff.

Moreover, the Superintendent is expected to lead the staff, community and Board in the development and on-going review of Board-adopted criteria and standards by which to measure the results of the instructional program.
