

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT/ASSESSMENT

It is the intention of the Windham School Department to participate in the statewide assessment of students as required by state law and applicable rules of the Department of Education.

The Committee delegates to the Superintendent or his/her designee the responsibility for developing, implementing, and periodically evaluating a system for assessing student abilities and achievements. The Superintendent will notify the Board of any proposed changes prior to implementation.

The system shall include an assessment of student academic performance by teachers not less than once each grading period. Reports of each of these assessments shall be sent to parents/guardians.

The data acquired from student assessment shall be used to evaluate, develop, and improve the school instructional program. An annual report of student achievement will be presented to the School Committee.
