Some of our fundraising activities included: a staff soup luncheon, a flapjack breakfast, a staff baked potato sale, a school wide calendar raffle, 3 Kids' Night Out events, Beanie eagle sales, Friday morning Smencil sales and a staff BBQ luncheon. Additionally, funds have been raised through the recycling and up-cycling of various products. Below is an approximation of what has been kept out of our landfills through our collections.
